

VILLAGE OF MAYO
BYLAW NO. 98-161

A Bylaw to Provide for the regulation of the speed limit in the Village of Mayo

WHEREAS Section 286 (1) (a) of the Municipal Act RSY 1986 provides that the Council may by bylaw regulate the speed of any vehicle within a municipality; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Mayo has been approached by Village residents to reduce the speed limit in Village boundaries for the safety of children, and

WHEREAS there are several areas in Village boundaries that are frequented by children (i.e. School, Playschool, Recreation facilities, playgrounds, etc.) and it would be advisable to reduce the speed limit in these areas to 30 km/hr,

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. The Village of Mayo, is reducing the speed limit in present Village of Mayo boundaries from 50 km/hr to 40 km/hr, and is furthermore reducing the speed limit in areas that are frequented by children (i.e. School, Playschool, Recreation facilities, playgrounds, etc.) to 30 km/hr by placing signs in these areas.
2. Enforcement and Effect:
For the purpose of this bylaw members of the R.C.M.P. will enforce the new speed limits as per the rules of the Motor Vehicles Act.

This Bylaw shall be deemed to come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 14 day of July, 1998.
