## **VILLAGE OF MAYO**

## **BY-LAW #189**

A By-law to adopt a municipal flag or emblem.

**WHEREAS** Section 227 of the Municipal Act states that Council may by bylaw adopt flags, crests, or coats of arms for the municipality and may make restriction on use, and

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council of the municipality of the Village of Mayo, in open meeting assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:** 

- The Village of Mayo flag shall consist of the Village logo on a grey background as shown in Appendix "A".
- The use of the flag may consist of, but are not limited to the following uses:
  - a) Flown outside of municipal offices
  - b) Flown at special events
  - c) Flown at meetings of Council
  - d) Flown at recreation events
  - e) Flown at royal and dignitary visits
- This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 6 day of 2001.

READ a third time and finally passed this 18 day of July 2001
