

VILLAGE OF MAYO

BY-LAW #189

A By-law to adopt a municipal flag or emblem.

WHEREAS Section 227 of the Municipal Act states that Council may by bylaw adopt flags, crests, or coats of arms for the municipality and may make restriction on use, and

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the municipality of the Village of Mayo, in open meeting assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Village of Mayo flag shall consist of the Village logo on a grey background as shown in Appendix "A".
2. The use of the flag may consist of, but are not limited to the following uses:
 - a) Flown outside of municipal offices
 - b) Flown at special events
 - c) Flown at meetings of Council
 - d) Flown at recreation events
 - e) Flown at royal and dignitary visits
3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 6 day of June, 2001.

READ a third time and finally passed this 18 day of July, 2001.
