

VILLAGE OF MAYO  
BY-LAW NO. 197

**A by-law to provide for 4-way stop signs at the intersection of  
First Avenue and Laurier Street**

**WHEREAS** Section 265 (i) of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 19 of the Statutes of the Yukon (1998) and Section 118 (1) of the Motor Vehicles Act provides that that Council may by by-law make regulations with respect to traffic at intersections, and

**WHEREAS** the Council of the Village of Mayo has been approached by residents living in close proximity of the First Avenue and Laurier Street intersection, to erect stop signs at this intersection for the safety of the public,

**NOW THEREFORE** the Council for the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. The Village of Mayo erect 4-way stop signs at the intersection of First Avenue and Laurier Street.
2. Enforcement and Effect:  
For the purpose of this by-law members of the RCMP will enforce the new stop signs as per the rules of the Motor Vehicles Act, the Motor Transportation Act, and the Highways Act.
3. This by-law shall be deemed to come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a third and final time this 19 day of June,
