## **BY-LAW # 235**

## A BY-LAW OF THE VILLAGE OF MAYO PROVIDING FOR THE ORDERLY NUMBERING OF LOTS AND BUILDINGS WITHIN THE MUNICIPAL BOUNDARIES

## **PREAMBLE**

WHEREAS Section 265 (a) of the Municipal Act, Revised Statutes of the Yukon 2002, Chapter 154 and amendments thereto from time to time, provides that council may pass bylaws respecting the safety and welfare of its residents, and emergency services, and

**WHEREAS** Section 265(j) of the Municipal Act, Revised Statutes of the Yukon 2002, Chapter 154 and amendments thereto from time to time, provides that Council may pass bylaws respecting naming of highways within the municipal boundaries, and

WHEREAS Council has implemented a house numbering system

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council for the Village of Mayo in the Yukon Territory duly assembled enacts as follows:

- 1) This by-law may be cited as the "House & Building Numbering By-law"
- 2) That all Highways and Roads within the municipal boundaries of the Village of Mayo shall be named in accordance with Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this by-law.
- 3) That the lots and buildings within the municipal boundaries of the Village of Mayo shall be numbered in accordance with the Schedule "A" attached hereto and forming part of this bylaw and as added to, or changed, from time to time by amending this by-law.
- 4) That every person taking out a development permit for the construction of a new building shall be informed of the number for the building and shall be required to have the same placed on the said building prior to occupancy.

- 5) Every property owner is required to have the number of their premise placed prominently, preferably next to their front door or the door most visible from their front street, in a location such that it may be illuminated by a light.
- 6) All building numbers must have a minimum height of four inches (4").
- 7) This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a third and final time and passed this Hay of Jule, 2006.
