

**The Village of Mayo  
By-law No. 279**

**A by-law to provide for an Indemnity to the Mayor and Councilors of the Municipality of the Village of Mayo.**

**WHEREAS** Section 173 of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory states that a Council may by bylaw establish the types, rates, and conditions of payments to be made to or on behalf of members of the council, members of council committees, or other persons (a) as compensation for attending meetings and attending to other municipal duties, of which up to one-third may be an allowance for expenses incidental to those duties other than those expenses in paragraph (b); (b) for expenses incurred while attending meetings and other municipal duties; and (c) for any other purpose relating to the person's municipal duties that the council considers appropriate.

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council for the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Council Indemnity Bylaw".
2. In this bylaw unless the context otherwise requires:
  - a) "community" means the Silver Trail area from Stewart Crossing to Keno City.
3. The following indemnities (honorariums) shall be paid to Council:
  - Attendance at regular and joint council meetings – Mayor - \$200.00, Councilor - \$150.00;
  - Attendance at non-Council meetings inside the community less than 2 hours – Mayor \$150.00, Councilor \$100.00, more than 2 hours – Mayor \$200.00, Councilor \$150.00. Full day meetings – Mayor \$250 per day, Councilor \$200.00 per day;
  - Attendance at meetings outside the community – Mayor \$250.00 per day, Councilor \$200.00 per day plus \$200.00 for time spent travelling to and from the meeting.Council indemnities shall be paid on a monthly basis upon submission of an expense claim form to the Clerk/Treasurer.
4. Travel expenses shall be paid as set out in the Village of Mayo travel expense policy while attending out of town meetings, courses and conventions. Travel expenses shall be paid upon submission of an expense claim form to the Clerk/Treasurer.
5. Bylaw #153 is hereby repealed.
6. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 7 day of March, 2012.

Read a third time and finally passed this 21 day of March, 2012.
