

**VILLAGE OF MAYO**  
**Bylaw #285**

**A Bylaw to regulate the conduct of the Municipal Election.**

**WHEREAS** Section 53 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, provides that Council may by bylaw regulate the conduct of an election;

**NOW THEREFORE** pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory, the Council of the Village of Mayo, in open meeting assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

**SHORT TITLE:**

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal Election Bylaw".

**INTERPRETATION:**

2. In this bylaw,
  - (1) "clerk" means the Designated Municipal Officer of the Village of Mayo.
  - (2) "council" means the Council of the Village of Mayo.
  - (3) "elector" means a person qualified to vote in a municipal election pursuant to the Municipal Act.
  - (4) "village" means the Village of Mayo.

**ELECTION OFFICIALS**

3.
  - (1) Connie Posein is hereby appointed Returning Officer.
  - (2) The Returning Officer appointed by Council hereby has delegated authority to appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks as necessary.
  - (3) Election officials shall, during their employment, refrain from any active or public support or criticism of any candidate.

**NOMINATIONS**

4.
  - (1) Council chambers located in the Village office are hereby designated as the place for nomination proceedings.
  - (2) Nomination Day is September 27, 2012.
  - (3) Nominations will be received by the Returning Officer no later than 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, September 27, 2012.

**PLACES AND HOURS OF POLLS**

- 5. (1) The advance polling place and the regular polling place shall be established in the Village of Mayo Council Chambers.
- (2) The advance poll shall be held Thursday, October 11, 2012, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- (3) The regular poll shall be held Thursday, October 18, 2012, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.

**FEES**

- 6. The following rates shall be paid to the persons acting as election officials, other than full time officers or employees of the Village of Mayo:

Returning Officer	\$25.00 per hour
Deputy Returning Officer	\$20.00 per hour
Poll Clerk	\$18.00 per hour
Board of Revision Member	\$18.00 per hour

**REPEAL**


- 7. By-law #258 is hereby repealed.

**ENACTMENT**

- 8. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the passing thereof.
