

VILLAGE OF MAYO
Bylaw #296

A Bylaw to regulate the conduct of the Municipal By-Election.

WHEREAS Section 53 of the Municipal Act, being Chapter 154 of the Statutes of the Yukon (2002) and amendments thereto, provides that Council may by bylaw regulate the conduct of a by-election;

NOW THEREFORE pursuant to the provisions of the Municipal Act of the Yukon Territory, the Council of the Village of Mayo, in open meeting assembled, **HEREBY ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:**

SHORT TITLE:

1. This bylaw may be cited as the "Municipal By-Election Bylaw".

INTERPRETATION:

2. In this bylaw,
 - (1) "clerk" means the Designated Municipal Officer of the Village of Mayo.
 - (2) "council" means the Council of the Village of Mayo.
 - (3) "elector" means a person qualified to vote in a municipal by-election pursuant to the Municipal Act.
 - (4) "village" means the Village of Mayo.

ELECTION OFFICIALS

3.
 - (1) Crystal Trudeau is hereby appointed Returning Officer.
 - (2) The Returning Officer appointed by Council hereby has delegated authority to appoint Deputy Returning Officers and Poll Clerks as necessary.
 - (3) Election officials shall, during their employment, refrain from any active or public support or criticism of any candidate.

NOMINATIONS

4.
 - (1) Council chambers located in the Village office are hereby designated as the place for nomination proceedings.
 - (2) Nomination Day is April 24, 2014.
 - (3) Nominations will be received by the Returning Officer no later than 12 o'clock noon on Thursday, April 24, 2014

PLACES AND HOURS OF POLLS

- 5. (1) The advance polling place shall be established in the Village of Mayo Curling Lounge. The regular polling place shall be established in the Village of Mayo Curling Lounge.
- (2) The advance poll shall be held Thursday, May 8, 2014, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- (3) The regular poll shall be held Thursday, May 15, 2014, and the hours of the poll shall be from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00p.m.

FEES

- 6. The following rates shall be paid to the persons acting as election officials, other than full time officers or employees of the Village of Mayo:

Returning Officer	\$25.00 per hour
Deputy Returning Officer	\$20.00 per hour
Poll Clerk	\$18.00 per hour
Board of Revision Member	\$18.00 per hour

REPEAL

- 7. By-law #292 is hereby repealed.

ENACTMENT

- 8. This bylaw shall come into full force and effect upon the passing thereof.
