### 1. Ron Gee – Welcome and attendance

### 2. Rick Laberge - Update on the current conditions of the Mayo River

- Bridge and sewer line crossing have been stable or coming down slightly
- No overflow
- Sections of open water closing slowly, very little open water left
- Generally conditions good

### 3. Update from Yukon Energy regarding hydro operation:

- YE flows went up to the range of 22 m<sup>3</sup>/s on Jan 15, 2017 and Wareham Lake is in the middle of its operating range. A disruption at Aishihik GS resulted in a bit more variation in flow than normal this morning.

### 4. General Discussion

- Continue the increase of flow every two days at 0.5 m<sup>3</sup>/s per increase. An increase to 22.5 m<sup>3</sup>/s will take place today. Mike H to notify group of each flow increase.
- We are about 25% higher flow than previous years at this time and may be at full flow of 24 m<sup>3</sup>/s by the next conference call.
