1. Mike O'Connor – Updates

- Mike welcomed all to the 2015-16 winter ice season for the Mayo River
- Discussed the procedures that had been prepared by YEC and that they had been sent out prior to today's meeting. Rick J did not receive them so Mike will send him copy
- Overview of meeting that was held in Oct with YEC, Village of Mayo and YG Community Services
- Same group of consultants have been hired to assist the group through events this winter on the river
- Once we get more snow and the weather cools YG will get the ice crossings installed in the event that the lower diversion channel needs to be opens

2. Rick Laberge - Update on the current conditions of the Mayo River

- Winter is starting, small amounts of shore ice is building
- All game cameras have been re installed and additional monitoring devices have been installed
- Full daily observations and data collection has started on Nov 1, 2015
- Noticed a large tree and roots had fallen into the river below the force main crossing

3. Guy Morgan Update from Yukon Energy regarding flow rates:

- YEC running at 22 CMS
- Will be ramping down flows to around 20 CMS
- 2 units at Mayo B up and 1 at Mayo A running
- Planning to take a unit at Mayo B down Nov 16, 2015 for annual service
- Unit would be back into service Nov 25, 2015
- Water levels at Mayo Lake and Wareham are full

4. Dave Andres – Comments on current conditions and impact general discussion

- No concerns until we see some colder weather and ice building

5. General Discussion

- Morrison Hershfield has agreed to host data and photos on their share point site. Forrest has agreed to ensure everyone is setup with password and will resend the email with instructions
- YEC had agreed to cover the costs of the Stewart River level sensor again so this data will also be available
