- Water levels are starting to increase slightly
- No real issues around backing up
- Some anchor ice is appearing and seems to disappear
- Game cameras are all updated with new cards and pictures were sent into Caleb
- Stewart River is still open at the mouth of Mayo River
- Frazil ice one day than none the next. River is running clear
- Ice coverage is quite a bit slower than last year

**3. Guy Morgan Update from Yukon Energy regarding flow rates:**

- YEC running at 18.5 to 19 CMS
- Warm spell in weather seems to cause Wareham levels to increase
- The Mayo B units backup as PM was completed on Sunday
- Water levels at Mayo Lake and Wareham are in good shape

**5. General Discussion**

- Forrest updated that the sharepoint was all up and asked that everyone signed in to make sure they could get in without issue.

- Will run at 17 cms for the next week weeks unless we encounter issues and will call if this happens
