

PERMIT NUMBER _____

Pursuant to the Village of Mayo Solid Waste Bylaw #268 this permit to scavenge is intended to provide further waste diversion at the discretion of the Designated Officer. A Waiver of Claims, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement is attached and must be signed and accompany this permit in order for it to be valid.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

1. No person under the age of 19 shall be issued a Permit to Scavenge.
2. By signing this permit, the permit holder authorizes the Designated Officer or his authorized representative to, without prior notice and without incurring liability for so doing, inspect scavenging activities for the purpose of determining if the terms and conditions of this permit have been met.
3. Issuance of this permit shall not relieve the permit holder from liability arising from civil or criminal activities.
4. No scavenging shall be permitted within the active domestic waste cell or from the transfer station bins or from any other area specified as "off limits" by the Designated Officer.
5. The permit holder accepts all responsibility and liability for injury or loss to the permit holder while on the Landfill site, even if it is the fault of the Village or others, in accordance with the Waiver of Claims, Release of Liability and Indemnity Agreement that is attached.
- 6. The permit holder while on the Landfill site shall wear safety boots with toe and shank protection; approved hardhat; safety vest and leather gloves. A long sleeved shirt; long pants; safety glasses and earplugs are highly recommended.**
7. The permit holder shall not use torches; grinders or any other device that may cause sparks or flames.

8. The permit holder shall leave any site at the Landfill that is being maintained by heavy equipment.
9. The permit holder shall follow the instructions, as per the terms and conditions set in this permit, of the Designated Officer.
10. Notwithstanding any terms or conditions of this permit, all provisions of Solid Waste Bylaw #270, as amended from time to time, must be complied with by the permit holder at all times.
11. The permit holder shall scavenge solid waste in accordance with Solid Waste Bylaw as amended from time to time.
12. The Designated Officer may revoke this permit at any time due to the failure of the permit holder to comply with any of the terms and conditions of this permit or for any other reason deemed to be in the best interest of the Landfill.
