

The Village of Mayo

By-law No. 97-152

A by-law to authorize the Village of Mayo to close a highway.

**WHEREAS** Section 254 (1) (b) of the Municipal Act, RSY 1986 and amendments provides that Council may stop up and close to traffic a highway or any portion, or re-open any highway or portion that has been closed to traffic, and

**WHEREAS** the Council for the Village of Mayo has been requested by certain parties to close the road that crosses through lots 22 to 26 of Block 19,

**NOW THEREFORE**, the Council for the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Road Closure By-law for the road leading through lots 22 to 26 of Block 19".
2. The road crossing through lots 22 to 26 of Block 19 is hereby closed as shown on the attached map and forming Schedule "A" to this bylaw.
3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

**READ** a first and second time this 28<sup>th</sup> day of August, 1997.

**APPROVED** by the Executive Council Member this 17<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1997.

**READ** a third time and finally passed this 24<sup>th</sup> day of September, 1997.
