VILLAGE OF MAYO BYLAW NO. 98-162

A Bylaw to Provide for 4-way stop signs at the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Laurier Street

WHEREAS Section 286 (1) (m) (viii) of the Municipal Act RSY 1986 and Section 118 (1) of the Motor Vehicles Act provides that the Council may by bylaw make regulations with respect to traffic at intersections; and

WHEREAS the Council of the Village of Mayo has been approached by residents living in close proximity of the Fourth Avenue and Laurier Street intersection, to erect stop signs at this intersection for the safety of children, and

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled, hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

 The Village of Mayo erect 4-way stop signs at the intersection of Fourth Avenue and Laurier Street.

Enforcement and Effect:
 For the purpose of this bylaw members of the R.C.M.P. will enforce the new stop signs as per the rules of the Motor Vehicles Act, the Motor Transport Act, and the Highways Act.

This Bylaw shall be deemed to come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.
