

**VILLAGE OF MAYO
BY-LAW NO. 226**

A by-law to authorize the Village of Mayo to close a lane.

Whereas Section 276(1) and (2) of the Municipal Act, RSY 2002, provides that a municipality may by by-law permanently close a municipal highway by registering at the Land Titles Office a plan that shows the closure, and such municipality proposing to permanently close a municipal highway must give public notice and hold a public hearing prior to final passage of a by-law in respect of the proposed closure, and

Whereas the Council for the Village of Mayo wants to close a lane to consolidate Parcel E and Block 36, Lots 1-6, and

Whereas the Council for the Village of Mayo has given public notice and has held a public hearing prior to the passage of this by-law.

Now therefore the Council for the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

1. This by-law may be cited as the "Block 36 Lane Closure By-law".
2. The lane on Block 36, dividing Lots 1, 2, 3, and 4, 5, 6 is hereby closed.
3. This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon final passing thereof.

Read a first and second time this 7 of September, 2005.

Read a third and final time and passed this 5th day of October, 2005.
