

**VILLAGE OF MAYO**

**BY-LAW NO. 239**

**A by-law to authorize the Village of Mayo to close an old road**

---

**WHEREAS** Section 265 (j) of the Municipal Act, RSY 2002, and amendments provides that Council may pass bylaws for municipal purposes respecting the following matters, subject to the *Highways Act*, the management and control of municipal highways, including temporary and permanent opening and closing, sidewalks, boulevards, all property adjacent to highways, whether publicly or privately owned, naming of highways, and lighting of highways,

**WHEREAS** the Council for the Village of Mayo would like to close a section of the old Mayo-Keno Road to accommodate Michael Schlittenbauer's lot enlargement,

**NOW THEREFORE** The Council for the Village of Mayo in open meeting assembled hereby ENACTS AS FOLLOWS:

- 1) This by-law may be cited as the "Old Mayo-Keno Road Closure By-law".
- 2) The section of the old Mayo-Keno Road adjacent to Block 29, Lot 6; Part Lot 12, Title #98Y1097; Block 34, Lot 1; Block 34, Lot 8; Part. Lot 12, Title #2004Y0670; and Block 44 is hereby closed.
- 3) This by-law shall come into full force and effect upon the final passing thereof.

READ a first and second time this 4 day of Oct., 2006.

READ a third and final time and passed this 26 day of October, 2006.
